Professor Ashok Shaha has dedicated his professional career to the training of medical students, residents and fellows. He was Chairman of the Advanced Training Council for Head and Neck Surgery and Oncology Fellowships in the USA. He holds the Jatin Shah Chair in Head and Neck Surgery at MSKCC and is an Attending Surgeon on the Head and Neck Service at Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Center.

Dr. Witterick is a Head and Neck surgical oncologist with special interest in sinonasal and skull base malignancies. 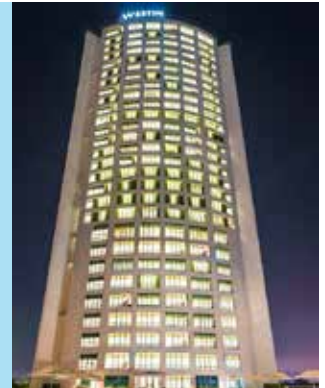
